The Herefords Northern NSW Youth group hold an annual Hereford Youth show for **Kids aged 7-25** of all experience levels, it doesn't matter if you have been showing for 10 years or if it is your first show.

Our camp is full of fun and educational lectures as well as Junior judging, Paraders/Handlers, Herdsperson and PeeWee Heifer dress-up Competitions. We host various age and experience groups to help suit all individuals.

Come along to our **2024** show to make new friends, learn new things, have a chance at winning some great prizes and seeing what the Hereford breed has to offer.



LOAN ANIMALS





This event has been designed to give young people the opportunity to build their knowledge and understanding of the beef industry, in a safe and welcoming environment. Activities will target all age groups and experience levels, and our committee will be available to help you. We have placed a strong focus on ensuring that the demonstrations are age appropriate and that practical skill and knowledge will be able to be taken away from the event.

For those that don't have access to a suitable Hereford animal, cross bred steers or heifers may be shown as long as they are at least 50% Hereford, if that is still not an option there will be loan animals available. Simply select 'Loan Animal required' in the entry form and leave the rest to us.

A **designated camping area** is available for participants to stay on the Show grounds. Children aged 12 and under must have a parent or "Camp Guardian" accompanying them for the duration of the Heifer Show. In addition, the Committee encourages all parents to attend, stay on the Showgrounds, and get involved in the program. The success of the event relies on help and participation from parents.

The Entry Fee includes the full educational and fun program, membership to Herefords Northern NSW, Friday dinner, Saturday night formal dinner, a competitor shirt, cap and promotional gear and the chance to win some great prizes.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entry with meal plan includes entry to the lectures/competitions, one animal entry, one meal plan for the duration of the weekend, one Saturday night formal dinner ticket, a competitor shirt, hat and Hereford promotional gear. 2. Entries strictly close on the 1<sup>st of</sup> November 2022. This is to ensure that shirts, merchandise, prizes and activities can be

finalized before the Christmas break. Please account for postage time if sending paper entry forms.

3. Camping is permitted on the Showgrounds however the Herefords Northern NSW Youth are not responsible for any injuries or loss of belongings which occur. A child under the age of 18 must be under the supervision of an assigned adult at all times while camping.

4. Exhibitors must be over the age of 7 and under the age of 25 as of the 13/01/2024.

5. Exhibitors do not have to be the owner of their animal.

6. Sizes for shirts must be sent with entries for ordering.

7. Cattle can arrive at the Show ground from 8am on Thursday 11th January and must not arrive after 7.00am on Friday 12th January 2024. REGISTRATIONS FROM 3PM THURSDAY 11TH OF JANUARY. All competitors to be at induction at 8am on the 12th of January (Friday).

8. Competitors with minimal experience may nominate as a Novice competitor and will only be permitted to exhibit one animal - please note on entry form if novice category is required.

9. Competitors exhibit at their own risk.

10. Schools/Colleges are eligible to participate, and every endeavor will be made in assisting to provide a suitable animal where possible.

11. Shoes to be worn at all times, ABSOLUTELY NO THONGS/SANDALS in cattle sheds or judging lawn.

12. Any disruptive or unacceptable behaviour as defined by the committee from any individual will not be tolerated. Such behaviour may result in disgualification from the competition and/or exclusion from the grounds. This decision is to be made by the Herefords Northern NSW Youth Committee in conjunction with Herefords Northern NSW Senior Committee and the decision will be final, and no dispute will be entered into.

13. No alcohol is to be brought to the grounds by Competitors. Competitors not abiding to this rule may result in disgualification from the competition and/or exclusion from the grounds. This decision is to be made by the Herefords Northern NSW Youth Committee in conjunction with Herefords Northern NSW Senior Committee and the decision will be final, and no dispute will be entered into.

14. All electrical appliances MUST be tagged in accordance with the insurance policy.

**15.** Herefords Northern NSW Youth Association decisions for special prizes will be final and no dispute will be entered into. 16. A current National Health Declaration Form must accompany all entries.

17. Duplicate (white or photocopy) Pedigree Certificates for each animal must accompany the entry form & registration numbers are to be provided. Steer entries require name only.

18. Bulls can only be paraded by competitors aged 16 and over, NO EXCEPTIONS. This rule applies to competitors who are nearing their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday but will still be 15 for the show.

19. Eligible heifers must be between 6 & 24 months of age at 31/12/23. Bulls must be aged between 6 & 16 months as at 31/12/23.

20. All animals to be registered and tattooed in accordance with Society rules and must have NLIS tags. Each of the following elements MUST be clearly legible in at least one ear; Herd code, Year code, Calf no.

21. Eligible cows for futurity class must have a calf at foot under the age of 8 months, MUST have been previously shown at a Hereford Youth Event across Australia, records will be checked. These animals are also eligible for heifer classes if under 24 months at 31/12/23.

**22.** a) Steers in the purebred class must be purebred Hereford and milk teeth only on the day of the show.

b) Steers in the crossbred class must be 50% Hereford and milk teeth only on the day of the show.

23. The owner/s of the animal shall warrant that they are absolute owners of any animal entered by them or by their authority to the show ground and shall identify the society and Herefords Northern NSW Youth Association incorporated against all claims on whatsoever ground and whatsoever cause made against the society or Northern group in respect as such animals at the insistence of any other person.

**24.** All exhibits must have an acceptable temperament, be broken to lead and conform to required health regulations.

25. All exhibits MUST be paraded with nose clips at all times while on the grounds. All bulls MUST have nose rings & must be led with a lead attached at all times.

26. Classes for judging to be determined after close of entries.

27. Exhibitors to supply own cattle feed and equipment – initial bedding supplied free (SAWDUST). BYO additional bedding. Any special bedding must be cleaned out before competitors leave.

28. Please send the waiver form on page 9 signed with your entries – without this being signed and returned you will not be covered by insurance thus will be unable to participate or compete.
